



Code of Conduct for Club Participants

Club participants are responsible for ensuring they conform to the standards of conduct, behaviour, equality of treatment, etiquette and good manners outlined in following Code of Conduct. This has been put together in conjunctions with British Gymnastics to help ensure all of our participants and visitors have a positive experience at Majestic Gymnastics.

1. Participants must learn the rules and participate within them.
2. Participants must be dressed in appropriate attire:
 - Hair tied back and away from the face
 - All jewellery removed
 - Gymnastics leotard, or fitted t-shirt
 - Shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings
 - Socks are not allowed unless you are participating in a trampoline lesson.
 - Garments with hoods, exposed zips, buttons or other attachments that may be a danger to the gymnast are not allowed in the gymnastics hall.
3. Use proper and correct language at all times.
4. Participants must give the club one term notice if they wish to discontinue lessons.
 - Participants will not be refunded if they choose to leave part way through a term.
 - Fees are non-refundable – exceptional circumstances will be considered.
5. Endeavour to establish good communications with the club, coaches and officials for the benefit of all.
6. Share any concerns or complaints about any aspect of the club through the approved channels.
7. Participants must not leave the premises without parental supervision.
 - Gymnasts must remain with a coach until dismissed.
8. Participants must not enter the gymnastics hall without permission.
 - If visitors need to use the toilet facilities, they must take a direct route there and back.
 - If you urgently need to speak to a coach, you should inform the receptionist.
9. Under no circumstances are participants to open the gym gate to exit the gymnastics hall without permission from the lead coach.
10. Respect the personal judgement/decisions of the coaches.
11. Respect the gymnastics hall and equipment.
12. Participants must not smoke, consume alcohol, take drugs of any kind, or be under the influence of any substance when participating in gymnastics at Majestic Gymnastics centre.
13. Participants must not eat or chew gum during a gymnastics lesson.
14. Respect the rights of others and remain courteous at all times. The club will not tolerate aggressive or threatening behaviour towards any member, employee or volunteer.
15. Inform a coach of any injury or illness before the start of the lesson.

Competitive Gymnasts

1. Publicly accept officials' judgements.
2. Discourage challenging/arguing with officials.
3. Recognise good performance, not just good results.
4. Ensure prompt arrival to training and events
5. Ensure club attire is kept to a high standard and you arrive well presented to events.
6. Set a good example by recognising sportsmanship and applauding the performances of all competitors.
7. Uphold Majestic Gymnastics values and ethos when representing the club at any outside event.
 - Be polite and respectful
 - Be motivated and eager to learn
 - Demonstrate honesty and integrity
8. Ensure your behaviour is appropriate and aligned with the Code of Conduct when representing the club during an event.
